		This course meets the minimum requirements under the Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997, but organisations who wish to benefit from a greater understanding of fire and fire prevention, and training in the use of extinguishers on live fire, should consider the Fire Awareness course.

		All employees as part of their induction or continuation training. (Staff with specific duties in the event of fire should attend the Fire Warden course)
