##### Course overview:

This course is for staff with a designated responsibility as fire warden or fire marshal, and provides the skills and confidence that will allow them to carry out their duties relating to fire safety and emergency procedures. The number of fire wardens that your organisation requires depends on the building design and use. In addition you should train extra staff to cover for holidays and illness.

Staff with designated responsibilities in the event of a fire

- **Be aware of simple fire prevention measures**

- **Be equipped to perform their fire safety duties**
