



FIRST AID AT WORK

Under the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 and Approved Code of Practice (ACOP L74), employers have a legal obligation to provide adequate and appropriate First Aid provision to their workforce, at all times people are at work. Correct First Aid provision can help employers reduce costs from injury, prevent minor injuries from becoming major ones and could save lives.

Each employer is required, by law, to make an assessment of significant risks in the workplace and to decide the level of First Aid cover required at each site. Once this has been established, First Aid at Work training should be undertaken by suitable employees.

FIRST AID AT WORK REFRESHER – TWO DAYS

Maximum number of candidates per course: 12

Duration of Course: Two days

Aims of the course:-

- To update and refresh the candidate in the concepts of First Aid at Work and in accordance with the Health & Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981.
- To present the candidate for re-assessment with the Examiners.
- To re-issue First Aid at Work Certificates in accordance with the Health & Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981.

Objective – The candidate is refreshed in the First Aid at Work principles and suitable to be individually re-assessed for the First Aid at Work Certification to a standard acceptable by the Health and Safety Executive.

Requirements - Before an employee is put forward for a course the following requirements should be considered. The employee must:-

1. Be currently certified, i.e. have a First Aid at Work Certificate, not expired, and supply proof of this.
2. Be prepared to continue to carry out First Aid within the work place whilst he/she holds a First Aid Certificate.
